Vera) must be differentiated from Cassia (Chinese Cinnamon), obtained from Cinnamonum cassia or C. aromaticum, which grows in China.

Cinnamon is not to be confused with another Cassia, Cassia senna, a Fabaceae (legume) family member, which is used as a laxative.
